Book Club News

This week we delved into the world of "banned books".

All Boys Aren't Blue by George M. Johnson was certainly an eyeopening book about a young African-American journey through his life as a black gay man.

He realized as a very early age of eight that he was different and there was a side of him the enjoyed doing things that were expected of girls. For example, he found great pleasure double Dutch jump roping. He had to force himself to do more expected male activities such as football, in which he excelled and played throughout high school. The author felt he had to go through life with two strikes against him – his race and his sexuality.

The reader felt perhaps a bit uncomfortable when the author discusses his first sexual experience which was traumatic for him. It was almost like a tutorial for George and his cousin was the teacher, taking advantage of his inexperience student who really was unable to give consent, while the cousin exploited his innocence and sexuality. The description of the event was really quite graphic but not crude. The author tried hard throughout the book to be direct and honest. We felt this particular event in the story did teeter on perhaps as pornographic to some but the readers found that the description presented in a matter of fact, non-sensational manner as acceptable. He explained to him health class sex education was non-inclusive- not taking into consideration African American or the gay community. He spoke of the importance of family and his love for his grandmother. In

the audible version the book is narrated by the author himself and states in the prologue he wrote about this so that young people who are in the same shoes can feel comfort in the knowledge they are not alone.






